Biographical history

Born in February 1946, Barbara Harriss-White became a lecturer in historical geography and South Asian Geography at London University in 1969. In 1972, she was appointed Research Officer at the Centre of South Asian Study in Cambridge University. From 1977 to 1981, she was a Research Associate at the Overseas Development Institute in London. Then, she became a Research Fellow at the Nutrition Policy Unit, London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine, London University. She moved in 1987 to Oxford University and taught there until she retired in 2011, first as a University Lecturer in Agricultural Economics, then as Reader in Development Studies (1996-1998), and finally as a Professor of Development Studies. She was Queen Elizabeth House Deputy director from 2003 to 2004, became then Director until 2007. She also founded and directed the Contemporary South Asian Studies Programme (School of Interdisciplinary Area Studies) till 2011.

Her fonds is quite comprehensive about her activities during this period. It does not include her post-retirement activities, such as co-investigators for two European programs (upon 'Democratic Culture' and 'Inequality and Poverty') or senior anchor of Oxford's 'Juxtapose' project (on the problems of comparing China and India). Throughout her career, she was mainly interested in rural India, economic development, poverty, social discriminations and gender relations. Her political commitments appear sometimes directly in the fonds, with for instance attendance at some political meetings or some pieces of documentation about labour and left wing political parties. Elected fellow of the Academy of Social Sciences since 2013, the quality of her work was widely recognized, even abroad, as shown by the fact she was nominated by the French Government in 2015 international member of the Conseil National du Développement et de la Solidarité Internationale.

From 1981 onwards, she authored or (co)edited numerous books and reviews, published mostly in England and in India. The subjects of these publications are closely related to the organization of her files. Until 2019, these publications include:

Content and structure area**Scope and content**

The fonds contains mainly sheets of paper (printed, handwritten or photocopies). There are also some sheets of transparent plastics and few floppy-disks and audio tapes.

Appraisal, destruction and scheduling information

Duplicates have been eliminated.

System of arrangement

The fonds was given in the form of 25 large cardboard boxes, containing 108 boxes, each one with its title, and few isolated documents, which were added to the 'Disability' subseries. The global organization of the papers reflects Barbara Harriss-White's activities as a researcher, her field work in India and other Asian countries, and her role as a teacher and director of Queen Elizabeth House in Oxford. If this order is new, titles given by Barbara Harriss-White and the content of each box have been kept as much as possible, but for few reorganizations within some sub-series (such as 'Regulation-1' and 'Regulation-2').

Conditions of access and use area

Free access with respect to French Institute of Pondicherry rules and to private life.

Language/scripts of material

The great majority of the documents are written in English, few Hindi and French papers.
